RESOLUTION NO. 06, SERIES OF 2002

“RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL COMMISSION ON INDIGENOUS PEOPLES, 2ND FLOOR, D & E BLDG., COR. A ROCES AVENUE, QUEZON CITY; TO ALLOW MINING OPERATION WITHIN OUR CERTIFIED ANCESTRAL LAND/ DOMAIN COMMUNITIES CADC- NO. 113, AT CANATUAN, TABAYO, SIOCON, ZDN.”

WHEREAS the Council of Elders during its regular meeting, hereby agreed that mining operation within the approved ancestral land/domain area shall be allowed with the following terms and conditions, to wit:

1. That CADC-holder communities have unanimously agreed that mining operation shall be approved, provided that open-pit mining type of operation shall be discouraged.
2. That only tunneling and panning types of mining operations shall be allowed.

4. That the concerned agencies shall formulate measures favorable to the accepted Subanon indigenous people's mining concept.
5. That whatever mining operation procedures be made and/or agreed between the CADC holder and any foreign investor, it should be defined and facilitated by the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP)
6. That the operational management shall be in accordance with the approved Ancestral Domain Management Sustainable Development Plan pursuant to R. A. No. 8371.

NOW THEREFORE, as unanimously agreed by all members of the council of elders present, it was resolved that mining operations shall be allowed within the CADC – No. 113 area at Canatuan, Tabayo, Siocon, Zamboanga del Norte.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the mining operations be in accordance with the above-stated terms and conditions.


