Gold Project in Surigao del Norte (12%), the Balabag Gold-Silver Project in Zamboanga del Sur (10%)

and the Agata Nickel Project in Agusan del Norte (17%)

**Advocating Gender Equality** 

This year's observance recognized female employees through storytelling, wellness programs and

empowerment workshops. At Siana, they were treated to a day of pampering and team-building,

highlighting the importance of mental health and self-care.

Meantime, in Agata, outstanding female employees were recognized for their commitment to safety,

sustainability and the community. In addition, a gender sensitivity forum discussed inclusivity and

gender-based challenges, fostering empathy and solidarity among employees at the Balabag Project.
